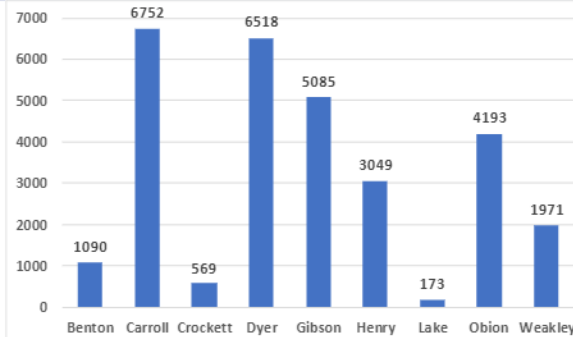

AJC Surveys Results

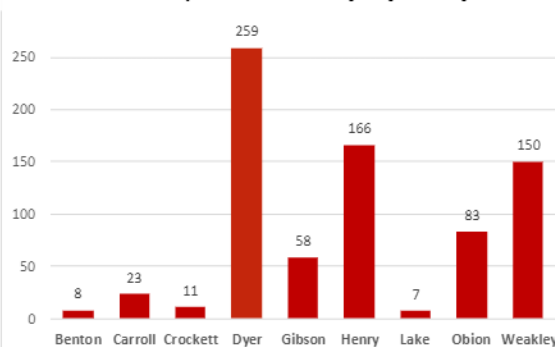

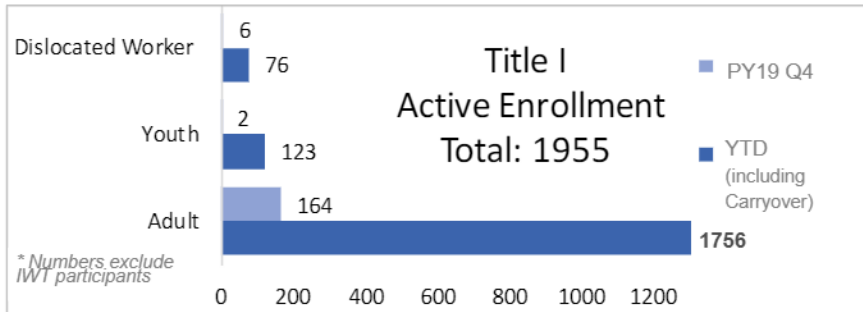

Title IV Vocational Rehabilitation

Vocational Rehabilitation served 693 customers in Northwest Tennessee, including 54 new enrollments during the last quarter. 23 were closed in successful employment.

Special Projects

The Northwest area has received \$249,088 in a **National Dislocated Worker Grant (DWG)** to support the COVID-19 emergency response. DWGs provide employment and training services for dislocated workers and other eligible individuals when an area is impacted by an emergency or a major disaster. Funding may be used to create temporary employment opportunities for eligible participants to assist with clean-up and recovery efforts, participant in training, and / or receive support services.
