

Executive Summary

On-The-Job Training (OJT) Best Practices and the Trade Adjustment Assistance (TAA) Program

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In this presentation, we present an overview of the rules of how OJTs work in the TAA program and compare it with OJTs available through other workforce programs. There is great discussion around barriers and obstacles to OJTs and whether they really are barriers and how they can be overcome.

We hear from New Hampshire and Georgia which have had success with OJTs on best practices. Their processes are highly transferrable. Examples are both specific to TAA and in partnership with WIOA.

We also share additional materials that may support strategies for outreach, paperwork, and case management.
