This H1B-Scaling Apprenticeship through Sector-Based Strategies (SA) webinar provided an overview of pre-apprenticeships. Participants received information on preapprenticeships, including the parameters for implementation of pre-apprenticeships in the SA grant, the elements of high-quality apprenticeships, and the benefits of implementing these programs. After this overview, a panel of practitioners shared their experiences with designing and implementing pre-apprenticeships for their programs, providing concrete examples of how they developed this portion of their programs and the benefits reaped.

The webinar provided:

- Foundational knowledge on Pre-apprenticeship, including clarification of terms and what is expected under the Scaling Apprenticeship FOA
- Information on the elements of high-quality pre-apprenticeship programs
- Effective strategies for implementing pre-apprenticeship programs and how they grow apprenticeships
- How to address common challenges
