This session provides practical tips for how to complete the new TAA petition form by exploring how a petition is read through the eyes of a DOL/OTAA investigator. Following these tips makes the front end of the investigation process run more efficiently, which cuts down on overall case processing time. A high quality petition filing clearly identifies the group of workers that is to be investigated for group TAA eligibility.

Other topics include reinforcement of policy provided in Subparts B and H of the 2020 TAA Final Rule (20 CFR 618).
