My name is Alexa Valencia, TAA State Coordinator and I am responsible for ensuring workers from << Employer>> are notified of individual benefits and services they may be eligible for through the U.S. Department of Labor's TAA Program.

The Department has approved a Trade Act petition for << Employer>> on <<DATE>>, making you immediately eligible to apply for individual benefits. TAA offers a variety of services at no cost to you which includes training, relocation allowances, job search allowances, and financial supports that can help you get reemployed in suitable employment.

How to apply

Determining whether you are eligible for TAA and applying for benefits is fast and easy!

- Complete, sign, and date the enclosed Application for Trade Adjustment Assistance • (DE 8309), and mail it in the envelope provided. Apply immediately to receive benefits.
- Once a determination of your individual eligibility is made, you will receive a notice of initial entitlement indicating your deadline dates and contact information for a TAA specialist to assist you.

If you qualify, TAA benefits can include:



Free training. Pays for training to upgrade skills so that you may obtain suitable employment. This includes classroom, distance/online, on-the-job training, and more.



Weekly payments while in training, even after your Unemployment Insurance benefits have been exhausted.



Payments if you find a new job to help bridge gaps in pay between your old and new job are available for those age 50 and older if earning \$50,000 a year or less.



Help finding a new job. Includes assessing your skills, career counseling, help with resume writing and interview skills, job referrals, and more.

Job search allowances can reimburse 90% of travel expenses to job interviews outside your commuting area.



Relocation allowances can help pay 90% of moving expenses for you and your family if you move outside your commuting area for a new job.

Health Coverage Tax Credit (HCTC). This can cover 72.5% of qualified health insurance Ųĵ premiums for eligible individuals and their families.
