For Scaling Apprenticeship (SA) grantees, sustainability can mean institutionalizing services and adapting to constant changes in the labor market, technology, higher education policies, employer nuances, and realigning funding streams. Webinar facilitators will help grantees consider and prepare to address the above factors to position their programs for future success.

- A baseline understanding of how to prepare for sustainability during active implementation;
- Information on the sustainability factors that should be assessed and considered as programs and services adapt to changing needs;
- An understanding of how the six SA grantee grant success factors can inform sustainability planning, and your individual SA grant program; and
- Access to the new SA sustainability assessment tool and proposed sustainability TA.

Zodie Makonnen welcomed participants and provided an overview of the presentation and then Janet Bray (MSG SA TA Coach Lead) and Mary Roberto (SA TA Coach) presented an introduction to sustainability in the SA Context followed by strategies for defining sustainability within individual grants. After an exploration of crucial knowledge to consider for sustainability, the coaches introduced sustainability tools developed specifically for SA grantees and explained the dissemination of the tools and the TA connected with tool utilization.

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
